Who requires this competency?	All managers, headteachers, team leaders, supervisors and nominated employees required to undertake risk assessments.
Knowledge and understanding required	<ul> <li>Understand their role in undertaking risk assessments in line with the requirements of the county council's Risk Assessment guidance and arrangements.</li> <li>Understand the difference between a hazard and a risk.</li> <li>Understand and apply the hierarchy of risk control measures by indentifying suitable precautions to eliminate hazards or otherwise control risks that hazards pose.</li> <li>Understand the HSE's approach to risk assessment and controlling risks in the workplace.</li> <li>Undertake general risk assessments in accordance county council guidance and documentation and recognise when specific risk assessments are required, such as, DSE, manual handling, lone working, etc.</li> <li>Have the practical skills necessary for adapting and applying risk assessment techniques to a wide variety of areas at work.</li> <li>Understand record keeping requirements and implications and the need to communicate the risk assessment outcomes to employees and others affected.</li> </ul>

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	<ul> <li>assess the individual's understanding of the subject material and their ability to apply it.</li> <li>Line managers will evaluate competency at performance engagement (PE) sessions and identify any further training or development required to attain or retain competence.</li> <li>Subsequent evaluation of the continuing effectiveness of the course learning objectives by line manager.</li> <li>As part of health, safety and wellbeing audits the competency of individuals involved in these activities will be monitored.</li> </ul>
