

Broughton Roundabout Improvements

Night time closures – April 2014

Night time (8pm to 6am) Sunday 6, Monday 7 and Tuesday 8 April:

The A6 at the Broughton roundabout, including all access onto and off the M55 at Junction 1 will be closed completely from 8pm to 6am.

- Traffic approaching from the north along the A6 Garstang Road will be diverted along Whittingham Lane through Longridge and onto Bluebell Way and Eastway. Southbound motorway traffic will join the M6 at Junction 31a via Bluebell Way.
- Traffic approaching from the south along the A6 Garstang Road will use the same diversion route in the opposite direction.
- M55 eastbound Motorway traffic wishing to exit the M55 motorway at Junction 1 will be diverted off the M55 Motorway at Junction 3.
- M6 southbound traffic wishing to join the M55 and exit at Junction 1 will be directed to continue south on the M6 to Junction 31 at Samlesbury and then back northbound on the M6 to exit at Junction 31a.
- M6 northbound traffic wishing to join the M55 and exit at Junction 1 will be directed to leave the M6 at Junction 31a for destinations south of the M55 or continue to Junction 3 for destinations north of the M55.

Night time (8pm to 6am) on Wednesday 9 April:

The A6 Garstang Road will be closed south bound from the roundabout to Lightfoot Lane from 8pm to 6am.

- Traffic approaching from the north along the A6 Garstang Road will be diverted along Whittingham Lane through Longridge and onto Bluebell Way and onto Eastway and onto Lightfoot Lane onto the A6.
- Traffic leaving the M55 West or East bound at Junction 1 will be diverted north along the A6 Garstang Road to Whittingham Lane through Longridge and onto Bluebell Way and onto Eastway and onto Lightfoot Lane onto the A6.

Eastway east slip leading to the A6 will be closed from 8pm to 6am:

- Traffic approaching from Eastway will be diverted to Lightfoot Lane and onto the A6.

Night time (8pm to 6am) on Thursday 10 April:

Eastway west slip road off the A6 will be closed from 8pm to 6am. While no A6 closures are planned, extensive traffic management will be in place.

- Traffic approaching from the south along the A6 Garstang Road will be diverted along Lightfoot Lane and onto Eastway, traffic travelling along Eastway will be diverted along Lightfoot lane onto the A6.

Night time (8pm to 6am) on Friday 11 April:

D'urton Lane will be closed at the junction with the A6 from 8pm to 6am. While no A6 closures are planned, extensive traffic management will be in place.

- Traffic will be diverted along Eastway and onto the A6 Garstang Road, or along the A6 Garstang Road and onto Eastway.

Please note: if there are unexpected delays we may need to carry out the work on different days.
