

**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BROUGHTON BYPASS
CLASSIFIED ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2014
THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

The Lancashire County Council hereby give notice that they have made, and are about to submit to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under Section 14 and Section 125 of the Highways Act 1980

Authorising the Council to:—

- (a) improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering);
- (b) stop up highways;
- (c) construct new highways;
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises;
- (e) provide new means of access to said premises;

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road to be known as the Broughton Bypass which the Council are proposing to construct between the junction of the A6 Garstang Road, 484m north of Broughton crossroads and Junction 1 of the M55 motorway.

ANY PERSON may not later than 11th July 2014 object to the confirmation of the Order by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, National Transport Casework Team, Tyneside House, Skinnerburn Road, Newcastle Business Park, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 7AR stating the grounds of their objection.
