- outcomes
- monitoring process and time-scales

The IEP itself should be reviewed at least termly.

If the decision from the IEP review in the term prior to the one in which the funding is due to cease, is that a further period of funding is required, documentation relating to

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this review will need to be enclosed with the submission for the continued funding to the Area Moderating Panel.
