

**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH AREA)
(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON
SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS) ORDER 201***

The County Council of Lancashire ("The Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45-53 of, and Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter called the "1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part 111 of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. Restrictions

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle, to stop or wait between the hours of 08.00 to 18.00 hours on each day, Monday to Friday inclusive, in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

2. Exceptions

Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the prohibited hours in the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:

- a)** the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for the purpose in any road to be used in connection with any of the following:
 - i)** building, industrial or demolition operations
 - ii)** the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - iii)** the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road
 - iv)** the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near land adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus or the exercise of any other statutory power or duty for the maintenance and supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus
- b)** The vehicle to be used for the purposes of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road
- c)** The vehicle to be employed in the recovery of another vehicle
- d)** The vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in pursuance of statutory powers or duties

3. Definitions and Interpretations

3.1 For all the purposes of this Order the terms described in this Article shall have the meanings specified:

3.2.1 “1984 Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended

3.2.2 “centreline” means the centre line of a highway as shown on Ordnance Survey graphical information systems at the time that the Order was prepared

3.2.3 “Civil Enforcement Officer” means a person authorised by or on behalf of Lancashire County Council in accordance with Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

3.2.4 “the Council” means the Lancashire County Council

3.2.5 “Driver” in relation to a vehicle left at or waiting in a length of road specified in this Order means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left at or is waiting in the said length of road

3.2.6 “Dual Purpose Vehicle” means a vehicle constructed or adapted for the carriage either of passengers or goods or burden of any description with an unladen weight not exceeding 2040 kilograms and which is either four-wheeled driven or meets specified requirements as to body construction

3.2.7 “Goods Vehicle” means a motor vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden of any description as described in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions Order 2002

3.2.8 “Penalty Charge” means a penalty charge imposed under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

3.2.9 “Penalty Charge Notice” means a notice served by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

3.2.10 “Public Service Vehicle” means a motor vehicle (other than a tramcar) which -

- i) being a vehicle adapted to carry more than eight passengers is used for carrying passengers for hire or reward; or
- ii) being a vehicle not so adapted is used for carrying passengers for hire or reward at separate fares in the course of a business of carrying passengers as defined in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

3.2.11 “School Entrance Marking” means part of a carriageway outside a school entrance as described in the Schedule to this Order where vehicles should not stop and indicated by a road marking complying with the Traffic Sign Regulations and General Directions Order 2002

3.2.12 “Traffic Sign” means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

3.2.13 “Vehicle” means a motor vehicle, a passenger vehicle, a dual-purpose vehicle, a goods vehicle, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage or any other vehicle of any description whether drawn or propelled along a road by animal or mechanical power

4. Miscellaneous

The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Act or by any other enactment.

5. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the ** *****, 20** and may be cited as the “Lancashire County Council (Ribble Valley Borough Area) (Prohibition of Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 201*

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The County council are seeking to ensure that vehicles are kept clear of important school entrances by making the keep clear markings mandatory. The safety of the pupils near schools is very important, cars parked in keep clear areas present a potential danger for children as they arrive and leave school.

North side, from a point 37 metres west of the centreline of Hesketh Road for a distance of 32 metres in a westerly direction

Berry Lane (Longridge C Of E Primary), Longridge

South-west side, from a point 23 metres north-west of the centreline of Chapel Street for a distance of 26 metres in a north-westerly direction

Brundhurst Fold (St Mary's C Of E Primary), Mellor

South side, from a point 43 metres west of the centreline of Church Lane for a distance of 44 metres in a westerly direction

Burnley Road (Gisburn Primary), Gisburn

West side, from a point 15 metres south of the centreline of Bentlea Road for a distance of 26 metres in a northerly direction

Chatburn Road (Royal Grammer School), Clitheroe

South-east side:

- i) from a point 167 metres south-west of the centreline of Green Drive for a distance of 31 metres in a south-westerly direction
- ii) from a point 198 metres south-west of the centreline of Green Drive for a distance of 31 metres in a south-westerly direction

- i) East side from a point 11 metres south of the centreline of The Sands for a distance of 26 metres in an northerly direction
- ii) North side from a point 4 metres east of the boundary of The Square for a distance of 44 metres in an easterly direction
- iii) South side from a point 11 metres east of the boundary of The Square for a distance of 44 metres in an easterly direction

North-west side, from a point 76 metres south-east of the centreline of Water Street for a distance of 27 metres in a south-easterly direction

Club Lane (St Mary's Rc Primary School), Chipping

South side, from a point 59 metres west of the centreline of Windy Street for a distance of 26 metres in a westerly direction

Commons Lane (St Leonards C Of E Primary), Balderstone

South-west side, from a point 84 metres south-east of the centreline of Unnamed Lane for a distance of 37 metres in a south-easterly direction

Derby Road (St Wilfred's Rc Primary School), Longridge

West side, from a point 15 metres north of the centreline of St Wilfred's Terrace for a distance of 26 metres in a southerly direction

Edisford Road (Edisford Primary), Clitheroe

South side, from a point 68 metres west of the centreline of Seedall Avenue for a distance of 44 metres in a westerly direction

Elker Lane (St Augustines's Rc High School), Billington

East side, from a point 156 metres north of the centreline of Whalley Road for a distance of 32 metres in a northerly direction

Greenacre Street (St James C Of E Primary), Clitheroe

South-west side, from a point 37 metres north-west of the centreline of A671 Whalley Road for a distance of 44 metres in a north-westerly direction

Greenacres (St Johns C Of E Primary), Read

North & east side, from a point 29 metres east of the centreline of Greenacres for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly then south-easterly direction

Longridge Road (Brabbins Endowed Road), Chipping

South-west side, from a point 22 metres north-west of the centreline of Brookfield for a distance of 38 metres in a north-westerly direction

Longsight Avenue (Pendle Country Primary), Clitheroe

North-west side, from a point 36 metres north-east of the centreline of Princess Avenue for a distance of 44 metres in a north-easterly direction

Lovely Hall Lane (Salesbury C Of E Primary), Copster Green

South-west side, from a point 96 metres north-west of the centreline of Hazelmoor for a distance of 44 metres in a north-westerly direction

Preston Road (Longridge High School), Longridge

East side, from a point 10 metres south of the centreline of Queen Street for a distance of 44 metres in a southerly direction

Princess Avenue (Pendle County Primary), Clitheroe

North-east side, from a point 30 metres north-west of the centreline of Longsight Avenue for a distance of 26 metres in a north-westerly direction

Queens Road (Ribblesdale High), Clitheroe

South-east side, from a point 79 metres north-east of the centreline of Turner Street for a distance of 26 metres in a north-easterly direction

Sawley Road (Bowland County High), Grindleton

North-west side, from a point 15 metres south-west of the centreline of Riversmead for a distance of 32 metres in a north-easterly direction

Sawley Road (Chatburn C Of E Primary), Chatburn

North-west side, from a point 8 metres south-west of the centreline of Ribblesdale View for a distance of 44 metres in a south-westerly direction

Sawley Road (Grindleton C Of E V.a Primary), Grindleton

South side, from a point 16 metres west of the centreline of the Unnamed Road for a distance of 43 metres in an easterly direction

School Lane (St Peter's C Of E Primary), Simonstone

South side, from a point 59 metres north-east of the centreline of Bar Cottages for a distance of 44 metres in a north-easterly then easterly direction

Straits Lane (St Johns C Of E Primary), Read

West side, from a point 6 metres north of the centreline of Tennyson Avenue for a distance of 38 metres in a northerly direction

Turner Street (Ribblesdale High), Clitheroe

North-east side, from a point 83 metres south-east of the centreline of Queens Road for a distance of 30 metres in a south-easterly direction

West Bradford Road (Waddington & W.Bradford C Of E), Waddington

North-west side, from a point 140 metres south-west of the centreline of the Unnamed Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 38 metres

Whalley Road (Barrow C Of E), Wiswell

South-east side, from a point 2 metres north-east of the Gable of No.1 for a distance of 26 metres in a north-easterly direction

Whalley Road (Sabden Primary), Sabden

North-west side, from a point 33 metres south-west of the centreline of Clitheroe Road for a distance of 27 metres in a south-westerly direction

Whalley Road (St Augustine's Rc High School), Billington

North-west side, from a point 99 metres north-east of the centreline of Elker Lane for a distance of 28 metres in an north-easterly direction

Whalley Road (St Leonards C Of E Primary), Langho

North side, from a point 22 metres west of the centreline of Access Road to Mitton Fold for a distance of 44 metres in an easterly direction

Whalley Road (St Mary's Rc Primary), Langho

South-east side, from a point 32 metres south-west of Coronation Terrace for a distance of 38 metres in a south-westerly direction

Wiswell Lane (Oakhill Rc College), Whalley

South-east side, from a point 25 metres north-east of the centreline of Springfield Close for a distance of 32 metres in a north-easterly direction
