

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(BURNLEY BOROUGH AREA)  
(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON  
SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS) ORDER 2010**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 17<sup>th</sup> November 2010 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45-53 of and Part 111 of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, the effect of which is to:

**Introduce** no stopping or waiting between 08.00 and 18.00 hours on each day, Monday to Friday inclusive, in the School Entrance Markings within the Burnley Borough Area as referred to in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order. Details of which are available at the locations and website below.

This Order will come into force on the 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2010, and any person wishing to question the validity of the Order may within 6 weeks of the date of making apply to the High Court for that purpose. A copy of the Order and plans may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of The Chief Executive, Burnley Borough Council, Town Hall, Burnley, BB11 1JA. and at the offices of The County Secretary & Solicitor, Lancashire County Council, P O Box 78, County Hall, Preston PR1 8XJ (quoting reference :LSG4/5/40507/TRO/SEM/12/JW) until the 5<sup>th</sup> January 2011.
