

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHORLEY BOROUGH AREA)
(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON
SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS) ORDER 2011**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 30th March 2011 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45-53 of and Part 111 of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, the effect of which is to:

Introduce no stopping or waiting between 08.00 and 18.00 hours on each day, Monday to Friday inclusive, in the School Entrance Markings within the Chorley Borough Area as referred to in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order. Details of which are available at the locations and website below.

This Order will come into force on the 4th April 2011, and any person wishing to question the validity of the Order may within 6 weeks of the date of making apply to the High Court for that purpose. A copy of the Order and plans may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of The Chief Executive, Chorley Borough Council, Town Hall, Market Street, Chorley, PR7 1DP. and at the offices of The County Secretary & Solicitor, Lancashire County Council, P O Box 78, County Hall, Preston PR1 8XJ (quoting reference LSG4/5.41848/TRO/8/JW) until the 16th May 2011.
