THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FYLDE BOROUGH AREA) (REVOCATION AND PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS) ORDER 201*

The County Council of Lancashire ("The Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45-53 of, and Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter called the "1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part 111 and IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. Revocation

Those parts of the 'Lancashire County Council (Fylde Borough Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009' as specified in the first Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.

2. Restrictions

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, to stop or wait between the hours of 08.00 to 18.00 hours on each day, Monday to Friday inclusive, in any of the lengths of road specified in the second Schedule to this Order.

3. Exceptions

Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the prohibited hours in the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:

- a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for the purpose in any road to be used in connection with any of the following:
 - i) building, industrial or demolition operations
 - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road
 - iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near land adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus or the exercise of any other statutory power or duty for the maintenance and supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus
- **b)** The vehicle to be used for the purposes of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road
- c) The vehicle to be employed in the recovery of another vehicle

d) The vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in pursuance of statutory powers or duties

4. <u>Definitions and Interpretations</u>

- **4.1** For all the purposes of this Order the terms described in this Article shall have the meanings specified:
- 4.2.1 "1984 Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended
- **4.2.2** "centreline" means the centre line of a highway as shown on Ordnance Survey graphical information systems at the time that the Order was prepared
- **4.2.3** "Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of Lancashire County Council in accordance with Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004
- **4.2.4** "the Council" means the Lancashire County Council
- **4.2.5** "**Driver**" in relation to a vehicle left at or waiting in a length of road specified in this Order means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left at or is waiting in the said length of road
- **4.2.6** "Dual Purpose Vehicle" means a vehicle constructed or adapted for the carriage either of passengers or goods or burden of any description with an unladen weight not exceeding 2040 kilograms and which is either four-wheeled driven or meets specified requirements as to body construction
- **4.2.7 "Goods Vehicle"** means a motor vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden of any description as described in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions Order 2002
- **4.2.8** "Penalty Charge" means a penalty charge imposed under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004
- **4.2.9** "Penalty Charge Notice" means a notice served by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004
- 4.2.10 "Public Service Vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a tramcar) which -
 - (i) being a vehicle adapted to carry more than eight passengers is used for carrying passengers for hire or reward; or
 - (ii) being a vehicle not so adapted is used for carrying passengers for hire or reward at separate fares in the course of a business of carrying passengers as defined in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

- **4.2.11 "School Entrance Marking"** means part of a carriageway outside a school entrance as described in Schedule 2 of this Order where vehicles should not stop and indicated by a road marking complying with the Traffic Sign Regulations and General Directions Order 2002
- 4.2.12 "Traffic Sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
- **4.2.13 "Vehicle"** means a motor vehicle, a passenger vehicle, a dual-purpose vehicle, a goods vehicle, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage or any other vehicle of any description whether drawn or propelled along a road by animal or mechanical power

5. Miscellaneous

The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Act or by any other enactment.

6. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the ** ******, 201* and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Fylde Borough Area) (Revocation and Prohibition of Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 201*
